Responsibilities:

The successful candidate will be responsible for:

- Oversight of Food Bank, Evergreen Meal Program Kitchen and Davis Centre Community Kitchen
- Advance the progress of YSM's Community Nutrition Education Project, focused on engaging marginalized community members empowering them to make positive steps in food choices
- Developing new and foster existing effective partnerships with food donor agencies such as Daily Bread, Second Harvest, PARC, North York Harvest and other relevant agencies
- Participate in the supervision, training and development of staff, volunteers, student placements and community members in various food related activities
- Strategic planning of fiscal budgets, weekly menus and food procurement through donations and purchasing
- Establish best practices for Food receiving and food storage areas, hygiene and overall safe food handling in accordance with Toronto Public Health
- Maintain relationships with corporate sponsors and volunteers to ensure maximum participation in meal program activities
- Overseeing safe maintenance of kitchen equipment and cleanliness of kitchen facilities
- Performing administrative duties as required
