OUR MISSION

YSM's Evergreen Centre, is a safe space for street-involved youth in Toronto aged 16 to 24.

Young people are welcomed by our warm and caring team and can freely access a range of supportive programs, including fulsome health services. Our current 700-square-foot location hosts over 80 qualified professional nurses, doctors, dentists and mental health professionals who volunteer their time to provide essential health services.

On average, 5,000 youth experience homelessness in Toronto. And of them, 2,769 turn to YSM's Evergreen Health Centre to access much-needed health care. This demand for health services far outweighs our current capacity.



DID YOU KNOW?

Youth experiencing homelessness face:

- Increased risk of respiratory tract infections, viruses, diseases and suffering with chronic medical conditions (Homeless Hub, 2011)
- A life expectancy 30 years lower than the national average (Toronto Public Health, 2018)
- A greater likelihood of hospital admissions for mental illness (Mental Health Commission of Canada, 2013)

From the beginning, our intention has been to serve more youth at Evergreen. The time has come to begin construction and move our health centre onto its own designated floor and into an expanded, purpose-built, custom space. The need is indisputable.
